Evolving to Meet Changing Needs

Community Impact

In 2024, the Community Impact team expanded its work beyond grantmaking to include impact investing, research and advocacy. The team also began to develop the Irwin A. and Robert D. Goodman Nonprofit Center (see page 7).

Jeneen Hartley joined the team as Vice President of Community Impact and Andy Davey transitioned to lead the Nonprofit Center.

Donor Engagement

This year, MCF piloted a third-party asset management program, successfully guiding a private family foundation through its transition to a donor advised fund while retaining its asset manager (see page 6).

Launching officially in 2026, this program will expand investment options for donors and create new opportunities for investment firms.

Finance and Operations

In addition to working with the Donor Engagement team on structuring the pilot program for third-party asset management, the Finance and Operations team established a program that allows Epic Systems employees to divest their stock to establish charitable funds at the foundation. In 2024, the team worked with six Epic Systems employees to process \$9.3 million in gifts to benefit the community.

The team also developed the infrastructure for MCF to manage impact investments (see page 8).

Growing Choices for Donors

MCF works with donors and their advisors every day to create plans to help them meet their philanthropic goals. Working with Lau and Bea Christensen and their advisors, last year MCF piloted a program to expand investment options for donors and family foundations.

Giving and Doing for the Community

Philanthropy and community are integral parts of Lau and Bea Christensen's life together. When Lau and Bea married, they created the Lau and Bea Christensen Charitable Foundation, a private family foundation, to facilitate their philanthropic giving. Since then, they've granted generously from the foundation and have grown it aggressively through its investments, as well as from personal donations.

Lau and Bea believe in giving time as well as money. "We often will make an early lead gift in a capital campaign and become involved in the organization, sometimes subsequently serving on the board," Lau said. It was their work to develop a planned giving program for Operation Fresh Start that led them to MCF.

"David Koehler (MCF's Vice President of Donor Engagement) was very helpful in developing a plan for Operation Fresh Start, and through that, we started developing a relationship with him and MCF," Bea explained.

Achieving a Personal Legacy

That experience with Operation Fresh Start made Lau and Bea think further about what they wanted their own legacy to be. "We had just figured our family foundation would go on after we're gone," Lau said. "But the more we thought about it, the more we realized we really wanted to have a more immediate, personal impact on how that money would be invested in our community." This led them to explore the benefits of transitioning their private family foundation to a donor advised fund at MCF.

"Our goal was to have the assets invested in the market and to continue giving from our fund, without limits, to support the causes that are most meaningful to us," Lau said. Ultimately, the Christensens wanted their fund to be fully distributed, in ways that reflect their shared values, during their remaining years and within the decade following their lifetimes.



Lau and Bea were attracted to the idea that they would no longer be responsible for all that goes along with managing a private foundation. But they were reluctant to leave behind their highly valued investment advisors. "We've had success with Buttonwood Partners for many years and felt gratitude and loyalty to them," shared Lau.

Working Together to Develop a Plan

Working with the Christensens and their advisors, MCF was able to pilot an arrangement under which their investment manager could continue to manage their portfolio, even after they transferred their funds to MCF.

"So, we have moved our private foundation to MCF, and the Lau and Bea Christensen Family Foundation is now the Lau and Bea Christensen Charitable Fund at Madison Community Foundation," Lau said.

During their lifetimes, Lau and Bea will continue to recommend distributions from their fund. "And when our time is over, we have confidence that the people at MCF will make sure that any money remaining in our fund will be used to follow our wishes in the community."

MCF will launch a third-party asset management program in 2026 to enable other donors and private foundations to follow the Christensen's lead.

Introducing the Irwin A. and Robert D. Goodman Nonprofit Center

On May 9, 2024, at the annual Madison Gives celebration, the Irwin A. and Robert D. Goodman Foundation announced a \$5 million lead gift to endow the Goodman Nonprofit Center at MCF. The Center, scheduled to open in mid-2025, will address a critical gap in professional resources for nonprofit organizations operating in Dane, Columbia, Sauk, Iowa and Green counties.

"The Goodman Foundation has worked with many local nonprofits," noted E.G. Schramka, Executive Director of the Irwin A. and Robert D. Goodman Foundation. "This gift will preserve and enhance the legacy of the Goodman brothers by ensuring that nonprofit leaders will have access to the professional development resources they need to continue to expand their impact."

Laying the Groundwork for Programming

MCF continues to lay the groundwork for the new Center, which will begin programming in 2025. After an extensive national search process, Andy Davey, formerly MCF's Director of Research & Advocacy, was named as the inaugural Center Director.

The Nonprofit Center, which is located adjacent to MCF's main office, will welcome its first Goodman Fellows Program cohort in September. The Goodman Fellows is a year-long program that will focus on professional development for nonprofit leaders. This group will gather monthly to build relationships and develop skills in areas such as finance, human resources, marketing, fundraising, advocacy and other topics.

Planning for the Future

As the Center is established, MCF plans to add additional programming, including bringing nonprofits together around common interests to collaborate: identifying gaps and redundancies in strategic plans for organizations operating in similar parts of the nonprofit field; and identifying opportunities to create greater change at the policy level through advocacy.

Investing in Small Businesses


In September, MCF joined other Dane County foundations to fund the Dane County Diverse Business Guaranty Fund in support of Forward Community Investments' new Small Business Lending Program. This fund, developed through the Wisconsin Philanthropy Network's Impact Investing Collaborative, leverages an impact investing model to expand opportunities for small business owners in Dane County who struggle to access the capital needed to launch or grow their business.

The Guaranty Fund targets businesses looking for start-up or expansion loans ranging from \$35,000 to \$100,000. Businesses working with the fund often are underfunded and undercollateralized and can struggle to establish relationships with financial institutions. Without access to the capital they need, these entrepreneurs find it difficult to succeed.

For these businesses to grow and thrive in our community, it's important that we increase the availability and variety of financial resources. The fund, managed by FCI, will provide a guaranty to loans made through the Small Business Lending Program, creating greater access to capital for these businesses.

Loans made with support from the fund strive to increase opportunities for entrepreneurs and improve the financial infrastructure to strengthen Dane County's business community. FCI also will provide in-depth short- and long-term services to businesses that have plans to expand beyond their current capacities.

Community Impact Grants Invest in Nonprofit Growth

In 2024, MCF distributed \$22 million into the community through three main channels: distributions advised by donor advised fundholders, money distributed to nonprofit organizations from their own endowment funds, and grants directed by MCF's staff and board from the Community Impact Fund or one of the 69 Field of Interest funds MCF manages.

Community Impact grants are probably the best known of these channels. This year, the Community Impact competitive grant cycle resulted in awards of \$1.34 million in grants to 20 organizations. MCF also awards noncompetitive grants from the Field of Interest funds to expand its grantmaking reach and impact with targeted and responsive support to nonprofits throughout the community that fit the guidelines of these funds. "These organizations are working hard to ensure their own financial stability while trying to creatively meet the needs of the people they serve," Angela Davis, Director of Grantmaking, said. "We're so pleased to be able to provide support to these organizations that are working to create new programs to serve the needs of their constituents, increase their own capacity and build long-term financial stability."



2024 Community Impact Grants

Community Impact grants are made in five focus areas: Arts and Culture, Community Development, the Environment, Learning, and Nonprofit Capacity Building.

Badger Prairie Needs Network

\$100,000 toward the expansion of its warehouse space, increasing capacity to accept and distribute six times more food for families struggling with food insecurity.

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Dane County

\$35,000 to collaborate with a grant writer to increase and diversify funding sources to better mentor and support the youth it serves.

CEOs of Tomorrow

\$65,000 to relocate to The Black Business Hub, which will provide a more vibrant, racially diverse environment, and to build capacity for strategic growth.

Children's Theater of Madison

\$40,000 to expand its development staff to increase sustainability, maintain strong donor engagement and support its 60th anniversary fundraising campaign.

Community Shares of Wisconsin

\$60,000 over three years, to continue to expand and support The Big Share online day of giving, and to help participating nonprofits develop their fundraising capacity.

\$75,000 to support growth by increasing staffing, finding a permanent location for its inventory and purchasing a van to help deliver these items to the increasing number of families left homeless by domestic abuse.

\$50,000 to hire an executive director to lead the organization through its next stage of growth and deliver the vision for the San Damiano property as a revitalized space for public recreation, events and peaceful reflection.

\$50,000 to support its advocacy campaign for the renewal of the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program, which provides valuable resources for conservation projects across the state.



Literacy Network

\$50,000 for its merger with Omega School, providing long-term sustainability for Omega School's services and expanding instruction and support options for those working toward their GED or HSED.



Madison Area Rehabilitation Centers

\$50,000 toward a new building that will increase capacity, improve community building and enhance the quality of services it provides to people with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

Madison College

\$150,000 for the Early Learning Campus, which will provide reliable, high quality, affordable childcare to students at the Goodman South Campus and help address the lack of infantcare options.



A Fund for Women

A Fund for Women is an advised field of interest fund at MCF that brings people together to support the women and girls of our community in reaching their full potential. Since it was founded in 1993, when a group of original donors gave \$100,000 to start an endowment fund, AFFW has awarded 190 grants totaling \$2.27 million to provide the women of our community with educational and economic advancement, safe havens and housing, and family supporting careers.

Roots4Change Cooperative

The Latino population is the fastest growing ethnic group in Wisconsin. But the healthcare system does not always meet the challenges these women face during pregnancy, especially for those who are new to the country. Recognizing this, six Latina and Indigenous women came together to create the Roots4Change Cooperative. It is the first co-op of doulas and community health workers owned, led and managed by women of color in Wisconsin.

R4C walks with immigrant families in their journey of parenting, childbirth, motherhood and womanhood. In the last six years, R4C members supported more than 265 pregnant women and provided thousands of hours of home, clinic and community support as community-based doulas.

R4C is building a network of Latina childbirth and postpartum health professionals across Wisconsin who are equipped with the traditional knowledge and collective values of childbirth and parenting rooted in their culture and heritage.


In 2024, R4C received a \$15,000 grant from AFFW to support the creation of the first Spanish curriculum for community-based doulas, including peer-to-peer mentoring that targets Latina and immigrant women entering the field. By making training and allied health workforce development more accessible to Spanish speakers, R4C will in turn help provide better care for immigrant women before, during and after pregnancy. "Thanks to this collective work we can embrace each other, support each other, and move forward and fight for our dreams as immigrants," commented a program participant.

Finance and Operations

MCF's diversified portfolio had another year with strong performance, returning 10.1% and beating its benchmark.

The environmental, social and governance (ESG) portfolio returned 6.4% — well below its benchmark. Its performance is challenged by the tech industry's stronghold on stock market performance. Several high-performing tech stocks are excluded from the ESG portfolio because they fail to meet the portfolio manager's ESG criteria. The investment committee continues to monitor the ESG portfolio's performance, and meets regularly with Commonfund, MCF's outsourced chief investment officer, to discuss it.

Going into 2025, Commonfund anticipated moderate economic growth, lingering inflation and less likelihood of a recession. However, the new year has brought declining consumer sentiment and business confidence, political uncertainty around tariffs and fiscal reform, and rising volatility within both the equity and fixed income markets. We are closely watching the impact of policy shifts on economic and market dynamics. Short-term risk is partially mitigated by MCF's long-term investment horizon.


Target Asset Allocations

Literacy Network

For 50 years, Literacy Network has helped Dane County adults who lack the English-language or literacy skills needed to navigate life in our community. Whether these people are looking to improve their language skills to better navigate day-to-day interactions, earn their GED or pass the citizenship test, Literacy Network provides small group classes and individual tutoring to help them succeed.

In 2024, Literacy Network absorbed Omega School after its long-time director Oscar Mireles retired. A grant from MCF's Community Impact Fund helped finance the merger, which will allow Omega School's programs that help Dane County residents earn their GED or HSED to continue at Literacy Network. With both organizations focused on the transformative power of education, the merger was a good fit.

As it works to integrate Omega School's programs into its services, Literacy Network will continue to focus on educational equity, addressing resource gaps and ensuring that every student, regardless of their background, can achieve their full academic potential. With the combined programs, Literacy Network hopes, in the first year of combined services, to help 175 participants get their GED or HSED.

"By merging with Omega School, we're opening pathways for students to easily move between different programs as they acquire new skills," Literacy Network Executive Director Robin Ryan said. "Students have told me that it is difficult to find a new program in town once you get comfortable at an organization. Having a wider range of services all within one agency has been wonderful for students."

Madison Civics Club By Youth For Youth **Project Fund**

When the Madison Civics Club board voted to dissolve the organization in 2023, they made the difficult decision because of a significant decline in membership over the past 10 years. But while the club may no longer exist, the group was able to ensure that its legacy would live on when it created the By Youth For Youth Project Fund at MCF.

Civic engagement was at the heart of the Madison Civics Club's mission, and the club began engaging youth in that mission in the 1990s, honoring students for doing good civic work in their schools and communities.

The focus on civic engagement also is core to the By Youth For Youth (BYFY) program, a program collaboratively run by United Way of Dane County, UW-Extension and the City of Madison that offers Dane County high school students a unique opportunity to make local investment decisions to support youth-led and youthdeveloped programs and projects in the county, empowering the next generation of leaders to make a real impact in our community. The Civics Club gift catalyzed a new wave of attention and fundraising for BYFY, raising the total they were able to grant out in the following 12 months to \$150,000 — the highest amount ever.


